
Recognizing that landscapes constantly change, evolving over time, Chad P. Robert is mindful of how his work will impact the site-from conceptualization of the design to conclusion of the project years down the road. "While I don't limit myself to an easily recognizable style, I am consistently perceptive of considering how each decision will influence the space over time," says Robert, who believes the proper planning of a site is paramount to its longevity and ultimate beauty. "As time goes on, trees become larger, creating shade, affecting flower bloom and influencing color scheme and plant sustainability. Trends come and go, having the ability to date a project." Moreover, to ensure the continual progression of his landscapes, Robert is responsive to the needs of his clients and those of the land. "Our designs are moving toward more passive and spiritual styles, reflected in quiet retreats, outdoor meditation gardens and outdoor massage areas, all of which have become recently popular requests. We have also started creating more vegetable and herb gardens, as well as incorporating green design. Clients view these types of projects as forms of personal meditation and expression," he says. "We are using many recycled materials and inventing innovative ways to use less water in our gardens. The goal is to advance with the demands of the time."
